# The award recognises

- Pluri-annual national Road Safety and Transport Plans, including vision zero
- Target for reducing road deaths and serious injuries
- Broad spectrum of organisations involved
- Science and knowledge-based approach

# The award recognises



- Average speed reduced by 1.5 km/h on roads with an 80 km/h speed limit (between 2008-2015) following comprehensive actions to tackle speeding
- Head on collisions reduced from 86 (2010) to 29 (2015) following infrastructure measures

 One of the most thorough driver training in Europe

## Still work to be done

- 117 deaths and 693 seriously injured in 2015
- → Target of no more than 500 people killed and seriously injured in 2024
- Safety of vulnerable road users
- → As walking, cycling and public transport are being promoted for reason of health, environment and sustainability
