The European Transport Safety Council and RSI 'Panos Mylonas' are delighted to invite you to the second YEARS National Event, held in Athens, to debate on the dangers and policy recommendations for young road users in Greece and in Europe.

YEARS (Young Europeans Acting for Road Safety) is a three-year project run by the European Transport Safety Council (ETSC) and the Parliamentary Advisory Council for Transport Safety in the UK (PACTS).

The project seeks to gain a better understanding of young people and their risk status on the roads of Europe, using the latest data on road deaths involving young people and the main risks they face in their first years of driving and riding. It also explores examples of good practice and effective measures that can be promoted and disseminated through national conferences in order to raise awareness among stakeholders and spur on national administrations to take action and reduce the number of young people killed on the roads.

The project has also been mobilizing university students to take action by running communication campaigns aimed at preventing young road users' deaths in their local area. In this latter stage the focus will broaden to cover the safety of pedestrians and cyclists as well.

Greece YEARS event is addressed to all those involved with and interested in Road Safety, the promotion of health and the protection of youth. The event's Agenda features road safety experts from Greece and other countries. <u>Translations from/to Greek and English will be provided.</u> Participants are kindly offered free access to the exhibition area by the Hellenic Motor Museum.
