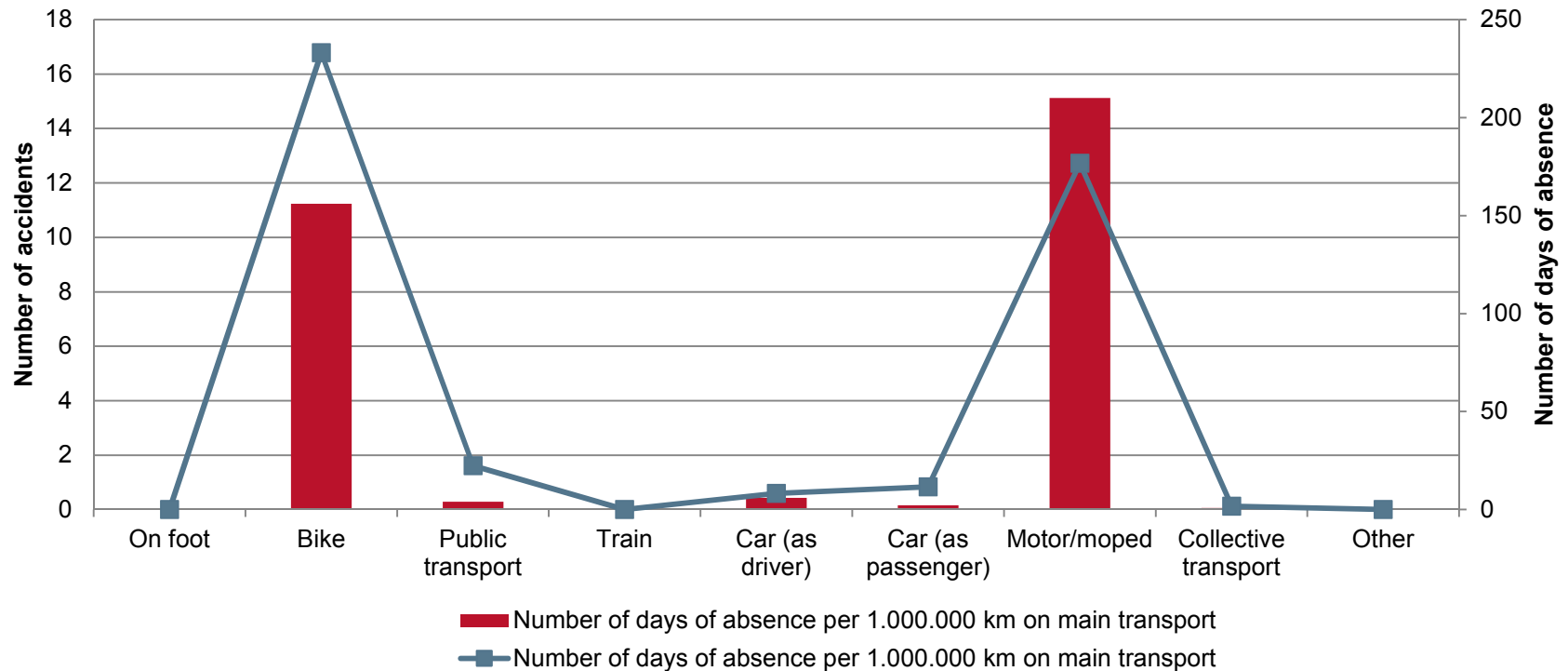


- Public authority: strategic importance for the Antwerp port platform

 - Providing daily communication about events and developments within the port

Indicator on safety of commuting traffic in the Port of Antwerp

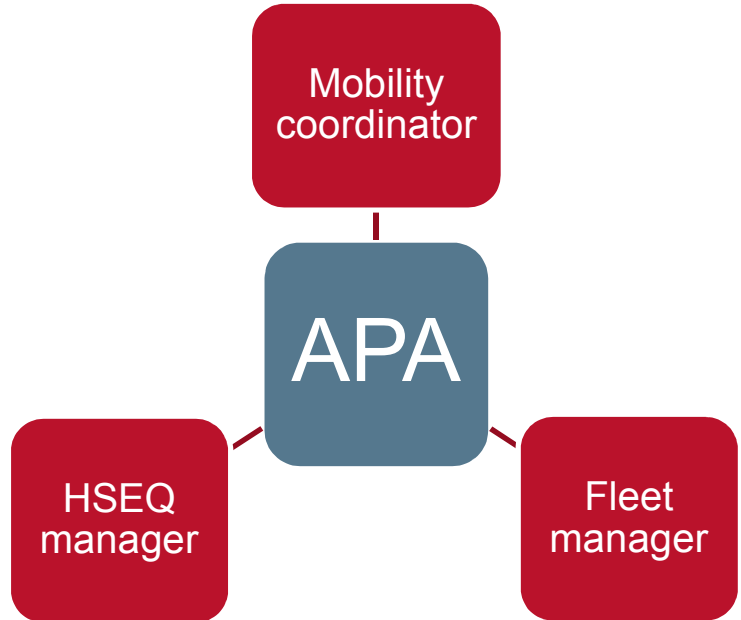
Research on commuting and road safety (2013)

Road safety – Antwerp Port Authority

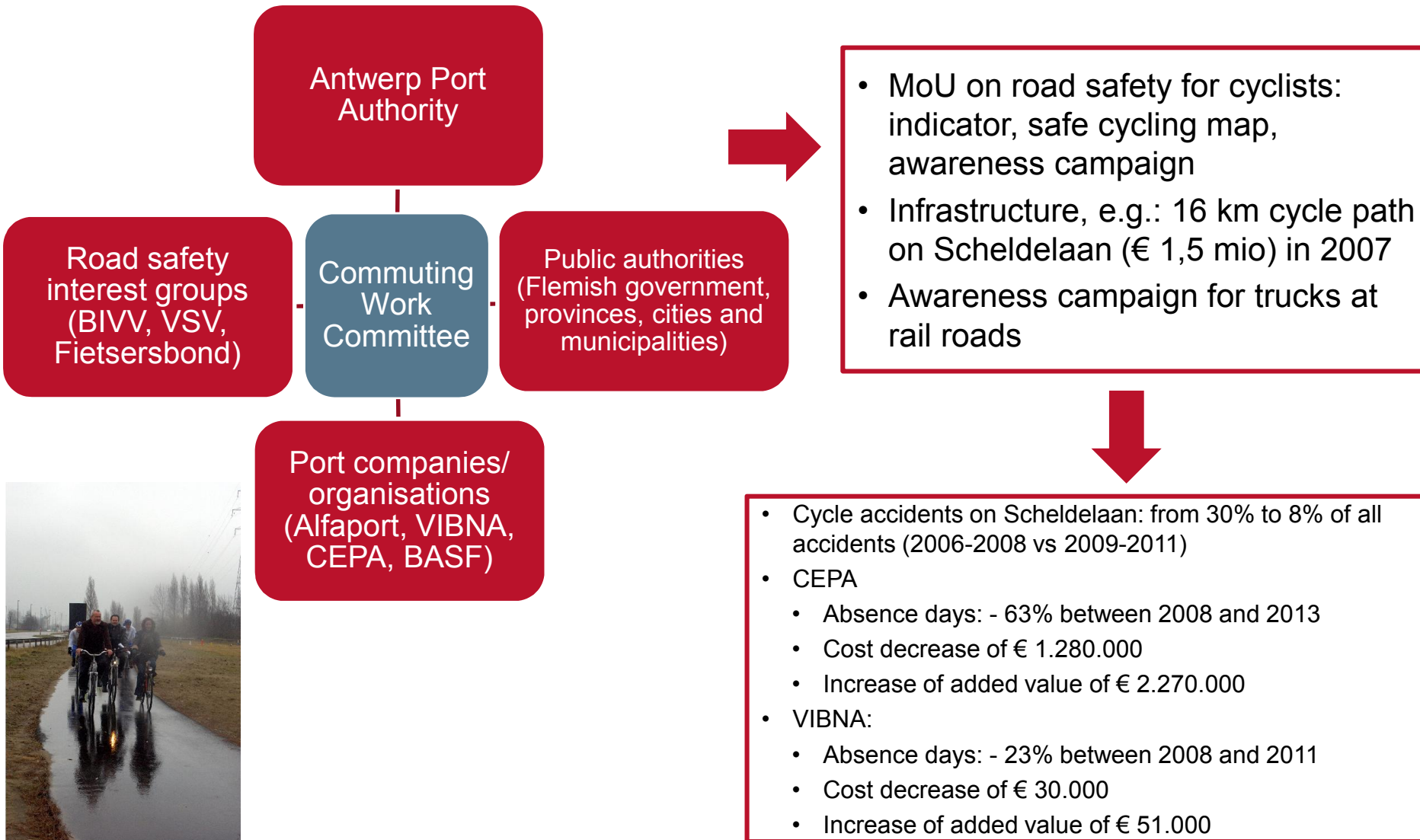


- Free helmet and fluorescent jacket for all frequent cyclist
- Free use of public transportations on frost days
- All company and utility vehicles must meet strict safety measures (highly visible and reflective colours, large windows, Bluetooth, etc.)
- Focus on safety in bike awareness campaigns (bike repair day)



- Absence days: - 19% between 2008 and 2013
- Cost decrease of € 60.500
- Increase of added value of € 107.000
