

- ✓ Traffic Safety Agency created in 2010
- ✓ Stricter sanctions for offenders

ETSC Recommendations

- ✓ Extend safety camera network
- ✓ Apply the Infrastructure Safety Management Directive beyond the TEN-T roads
- ✓ Introduce alcohol interlocks in rehabilitation programs
