
Humans are fairly blind to speeds (same applies for drink driving, not wearing seat belt...)

TRAFIKVERKET

Effectiveness of enforcement

- Act as a deterrent: people will not commit an offence because they fear they will get caught.
- Needs a high level of enforcement + media to talk about it
- Sanctions should be fair, equitable and escalate: low level of sanction for low risk, high level of sanctions for high risk
- Level of sanctions = social acceptance of the offence
- High sanctions = anti-social behaviour





Recommendations

- Set enforcement plans with yearly targets for numbers of checks and compliance with traffic laws, in particular addressing the priority areas
- Increase/maintain human and financial resources for the Police to enforce traffic law
- Extend safety camera network
- Participate in TISPOL cross-border enforcement actions
- Link road safety campaigns with enforcement activities
