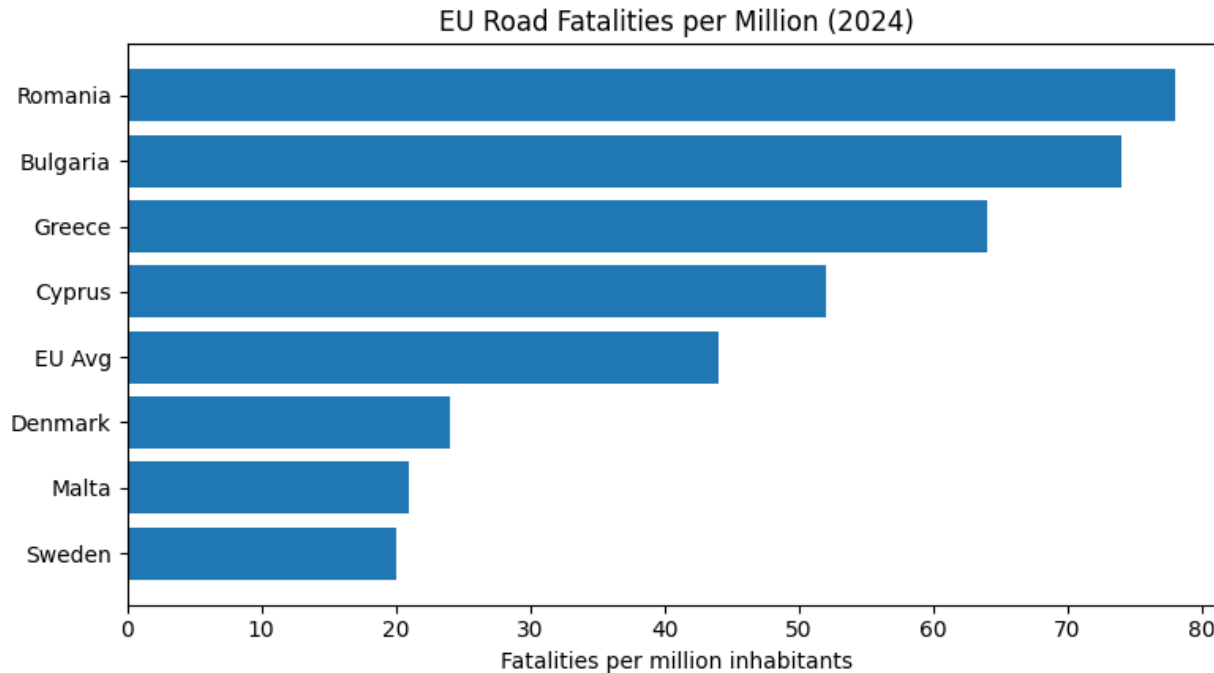
FACTS FOR ROAD SAFETY IN EUROPE

EU average: 44 fatalities per million inhabitants

Southern European countries remain above EU average

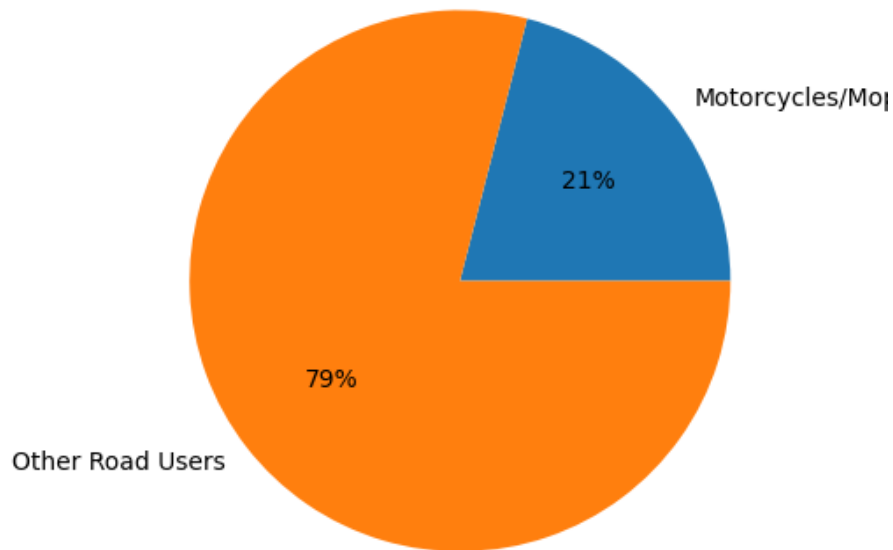
Cyprus faces similar road safety challenges



Motorcyclists Remain High-Risk Road Users

Motorcycles and mopeds account for ~21% of EU road deaths
Motorcyclists remain among the most vulnerable road users
Training and protective equipment are critical

Share of Motorcycle Fatalities in EU Road Deaths

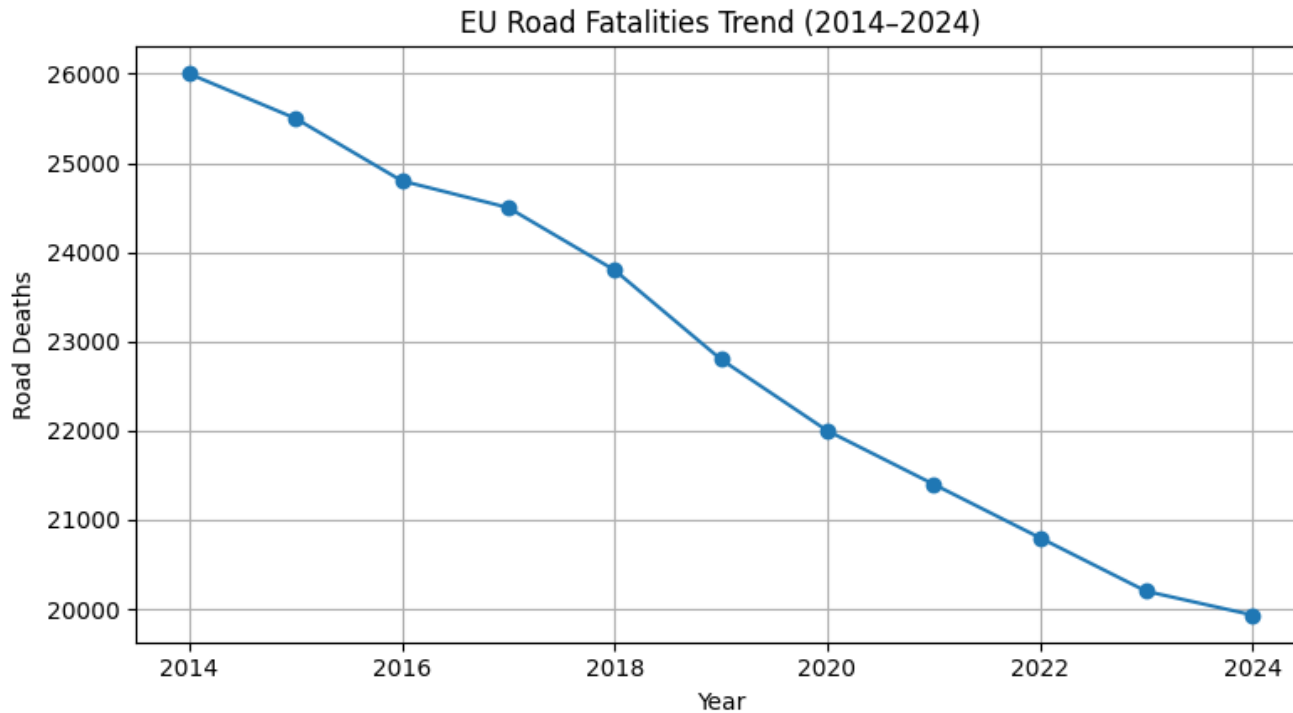


EU Road Fatalities Trend (2014–2024)

The on-site testing procedure involving DVR examiners will happen when COVID-19 situation permits it.

New Helmet Certification EC.2206 Explained

- The helmet being hit at multiple locations and speeds→ 22.06 uses many more impact scenarios than 22.05.
- Extra testing equipment around the visor and chin bar
- newer **angled and rotational impact tests**
- ECE 22.06 replicate **real-world crash dynamics**, not just straight vertical hits.



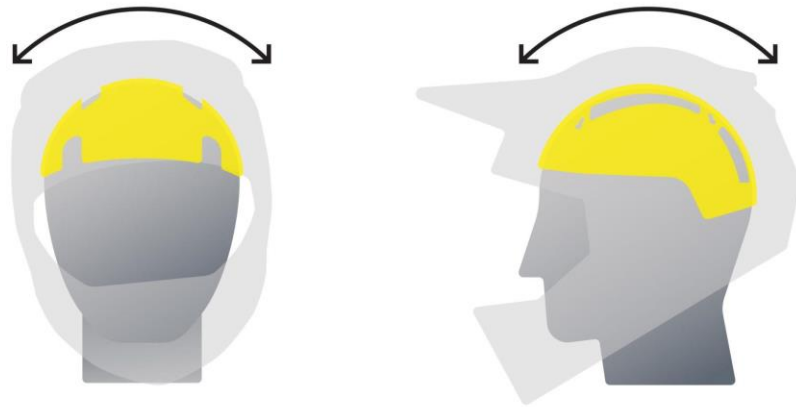

Helmets new technologies - MIPS



Helmet quality Explained

A MIPS-equipped helmet includes a **low-friction inner layer** that can move slightly (usually 10–15 mm) relative to the outer shell.

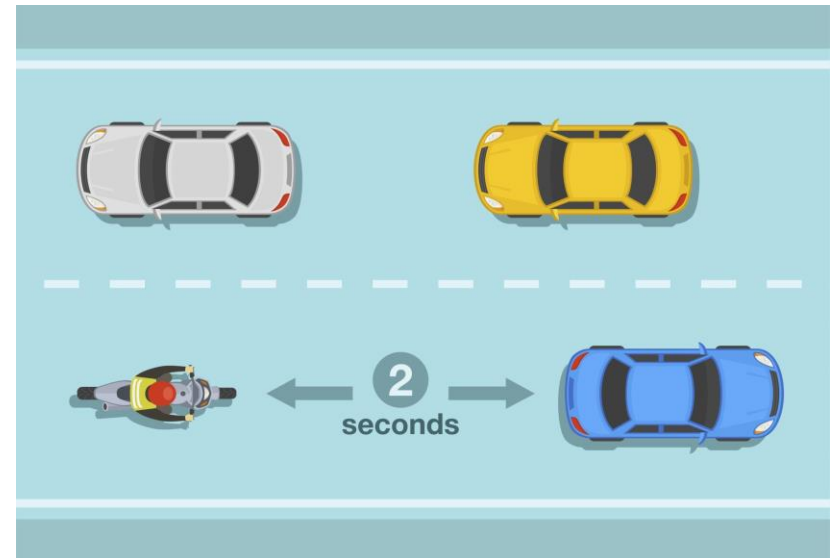
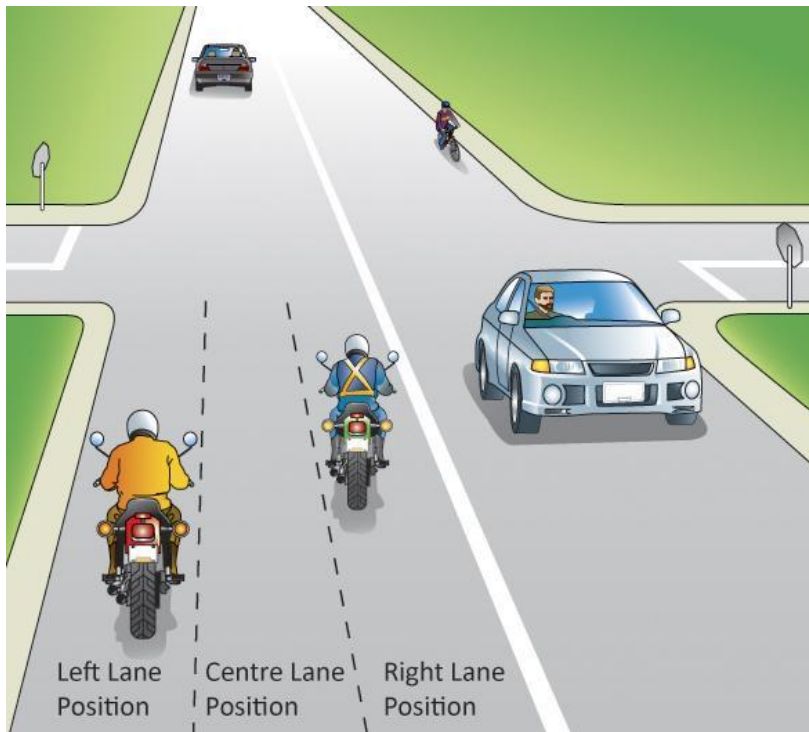
