850 persons in the Al program in Belgium






- Legislation 2009, amendment 2018
- Mhos
 - Repeat offenders ≥ 1,2 BAC (1-3y/definitely) + driving ban + rehab exams
 - First offenders ≥ 1,8 BAC, unless clear justification by judge
 - (Offenders ≥ 0.8 BAC)
 - → Not for addicts (withdrawal for medical reason)







