
Evolution 2007 - 2015

- 6. Seat belt & Speed (tumble car crash car & reactiontests : safety distance, brake test, use of telephone)
- 7. Driving simulators (truck motorcycle)
- 8. Safety & Security (load securing ADR "spill drill" ergonomics)




















































































"Road Safety Weeks"



In units

- → Integration of issues related to road safety in their training
 f.i. first aid / health-issues / regulations / eco-driving / driver skills / prevention...
- → Inform the personnel : flyers / intranet / marquee...
- → Military Police organizes extra road controls









Monitoring driving behaviour



SMART-Project

Safety Monitoring & Advice for Road Transport

Start up: 250 vehicles



- Installation of SMART-box:
 - <u>Tested aspects</u>:
 - Braking (too hard)
 - Acceleration (too fast)
 - Curving (too fast)
 - Speed (unadapted)
 - Driving upwards speed bumps (too fast)
 - Idling (stationary turning of the engine)

SMART-Project

Safety Monitoring & Advice for Road Transport



- Concept: Transportadvisor ("Master driver")
 - (Coach & Link between drivers and management)
 - → Monitoring
 - Not only focussing on the driver
 - → Advice
 - A correct advice
 - → advice rapport (if necessary)
 - Motivating the driver



Monitoring driving behaviour



Driver skills

- At least twice a year drivers have to follow a function specific training
- In 2016 : Installation of 2 off-road training circuits
- In 2016 : Installation of 12 different driving simulators
 - Contact teams: Instruction by military driving instructors
 - → Adapted training (Even in units & in operations)
 - Land Accident Investigation Service (LAIS):
