

Estonia

- ❖ Population 1,3 million
- ❖Size 45,227 square kilometres
- 34 persons per square kilometre
- ❖ Ca 700 000 vehicles
- Ca 630 000 driving licence owners
- Driving under the influence of alcohol is prohibited.




Number of accidents, fatalities and injuries in 1990-2017





Share of drunk driver involved fatalities varies from 10% (2016) to 44% (2007)


Road traffic injuries in Estonia 1990-2017

litres per capita aged 15 and over in 100% alcohol


According to the WHO, the consumption of absolute alcohol in quantities exceeding **6 litres** per person will result in major harm to public health.



Awareness campaigns (1)

- 20 years of alcohol-related awareness raising campaigns (started in 1997)
- At least <u>one</u> nation-wide media campaign with other supporting side- events organised by ERA, police, NGO-s or private companies
- Surveys to know the <u>effectiveness of campaigns</u> since 2011;
- Focuse on zero tolerance towards drink driving
- Messages are well supported by media




DUI enforcement

- Alcohol roadside breath tests are actively done by Police
- Serious consequences for driver:
 - 0,2-0,49mg/g penalty up to 400 euros, driving license ban up to 6 months
 - 0,5-1,49mg/g penalty up to 12 000 euros, driving license ban up to 12 months, arrest, possible seizure of the vehicle.
 - ❖ 1,5 or more mg/g, penalty rate depends on the income, driving license ban 3 to 36 months, possible seizure of the vehicle.





DUI enforcement 2010 - 2017




Risk behavior prevention courses for youth

Organized by ERA in cooperation with Police

- Target groups are the 9th (45 min) and 12th (7*45 min) grade students.
- Conducted by professionals (traffic psychologist, journalist, police officers, traffic specialist, driving teachers)
- Relevant methods are followed
- Around 20% of the one year students covered at the moment









Rehabilitation programmes since 2011

- For those who have been driving under the influence of alcohol (mainly high BAC offenders) and:
 - willing to change
 - Believe to be able to change
- Initiated by Police or Prosecutor office before determination of punishment
- Conducted by professionals https://jkoolitus.eu
- Relevant methods are followed
- 4 modules (180 min) with a week in between;
- Themes covered: alcohol influence on human physiology, DUI influence on traffic behaviour, alcohol consumption and traffic behaviour selfassessment
- Charge 230 eur + VAT
- The punishment will be decreased, if the terms are followed
