

Road deaths per million inhabitants



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Vehicle safety standards and legislation




Seat belts are compulsory throughout Europe

Proportion of cars by age



Proportion of EuroNCAP tested cars (2010-2013) sold in 2013



Average pedestrian protection scores of cars sold in 2013







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Pedestrian, cyclist and PTW user deaths as a percentage of all road deaths



KSI casualties - all cars







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Conclusions



- Comparing Britain's car fleet to the rest of Europe:
 - Britain has more older cars and a lower proportion of new cars with 5 stars
 - The average pedestrian protection score for new cars is lower

- To reduce the fatality rate further:
 - Improve vehicle safety for pedestrians and other VRUs
 - Investigate how differences in NCAP scores impact on real-world outcomes
