



Road safety progress 2014-2024














Figure 11. Mixed substance abuse in fatal drug driving accidents in 2016–2020.

Drug driving - countermeasures

Legal limits/'per se' laws

• Establish a fixed substance limit – similar to BAC levels. Any driver detected with a substance reaching or exceeding the legal limit is considered to have broken the law.

Zero tolerance laws

Set legal limits with a concentration set at the lab limit of detection. Any driver with a
detectable amount of a relevant substance is considered to have broken the law.

Impairment legislation

 In each case it must be proven that the skills of the driver were adversely affected by a specific drug. Signs of impairment are usually observed and recorded by the police when they stop a driver.

Drug driving - countermeasures

Penalties

- Withdrawal of the licence
- Fines
- Prison

Education and campaigns

- In school, at work, public
- Target high risk groups
- Helps increase social disapproval
- Education for professionals

Enforcement



- Post-collision forensic testing


Rehabilitation and healthcare


Drink driving schemes used as a basis

- reduce recidivism, restore mobility in a safe way
- Little evaluation of drug driving schemes
 Healthcare strategies
- General drug use, medical professionals and licensing authorities
