The European Transport Safety Council (ETSC), the German Association of Technical Inspection Agencies (VdTÜV) and Transport & Environment (T&E) are holding a lunch debate in the Members' Salon of the European Parliament on 27 June at 12:45 to discuss the Commission's proposals published on May 17 for the revision of two critical regulations for road safety: the General Safety (661/2009) and Pedestrian Safety (79/2009) Regulations.

These regulations represent the most direct and effective measures the EU has to further reduce road deaths and injuries. 25,300 people lost their lives on EU roads in 2017 – a figure that has hardly budged in four years. A further 135,000 people are seriously injured each year.
