More attractive and sustainable city

- Paris taking new steps to improve air quality in the city
- Reduced speed to 30 km/h in city center from sept 2021.
- Wants to stimulate and increase walking, cykling and public transports







Road safety foot prints

Half of all road fatal crashes occur in the value chain from commercial traffic





Value Chain

Multinational companys supply chain starts in low and middle income countries and end up in high income countries.





"Sustainable speeds" – Procurement as a tool to increase speed compliance



- Initiative 2019: National gathering where some of the biggest transport buyers express expectations of non-speeding in transports beeing purchased.
- Common requirement formulations hav been developed.
- From 2022: Requirement that the supplier measures and reports deviations in speed compliance at aggregated level



Geofencing Examples of activities

 Speed secured zon in the city of Enköping, personal and goods delivery



 A big timber company (SCA) use geofencing to control max speed through small villages in northern Sweden
