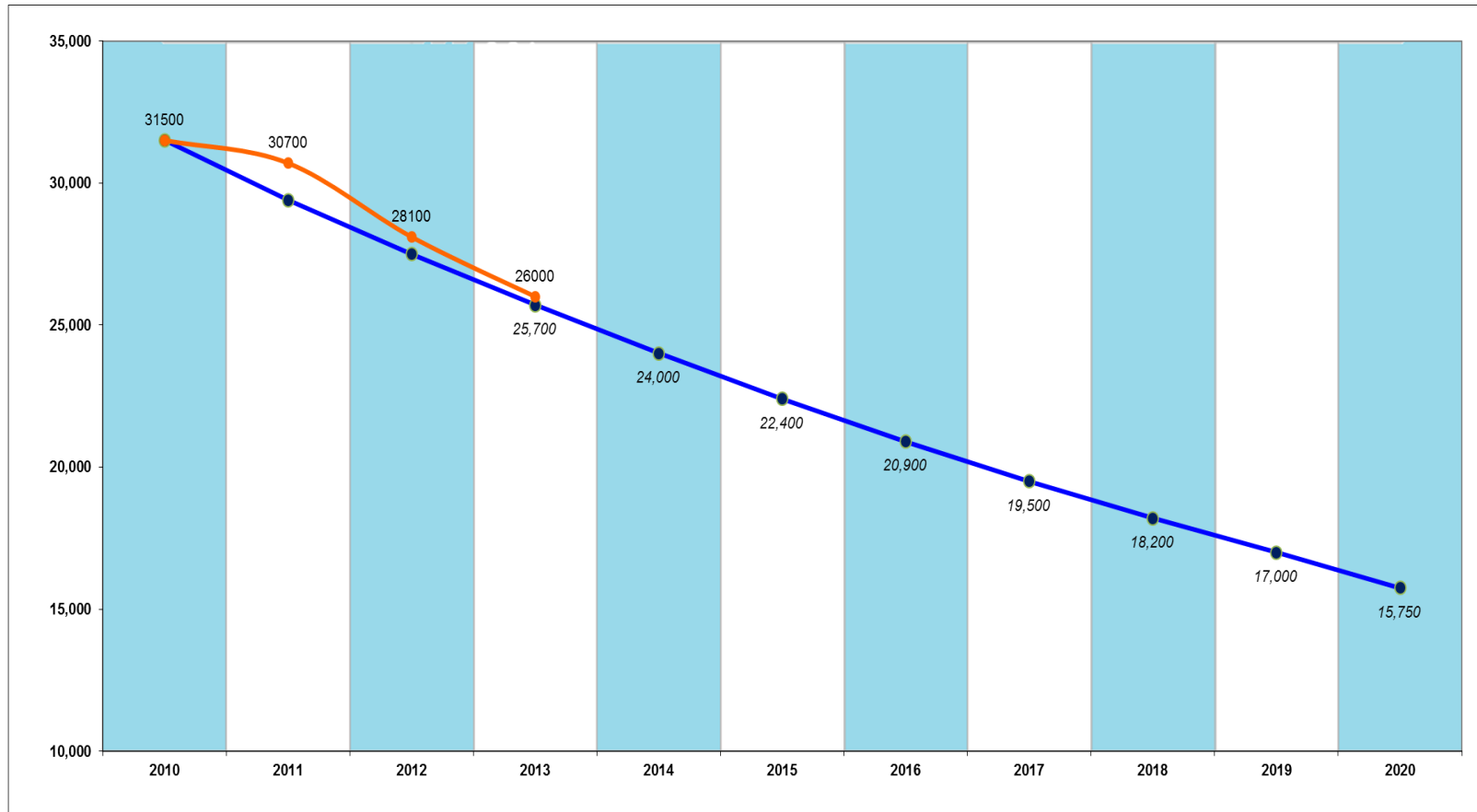

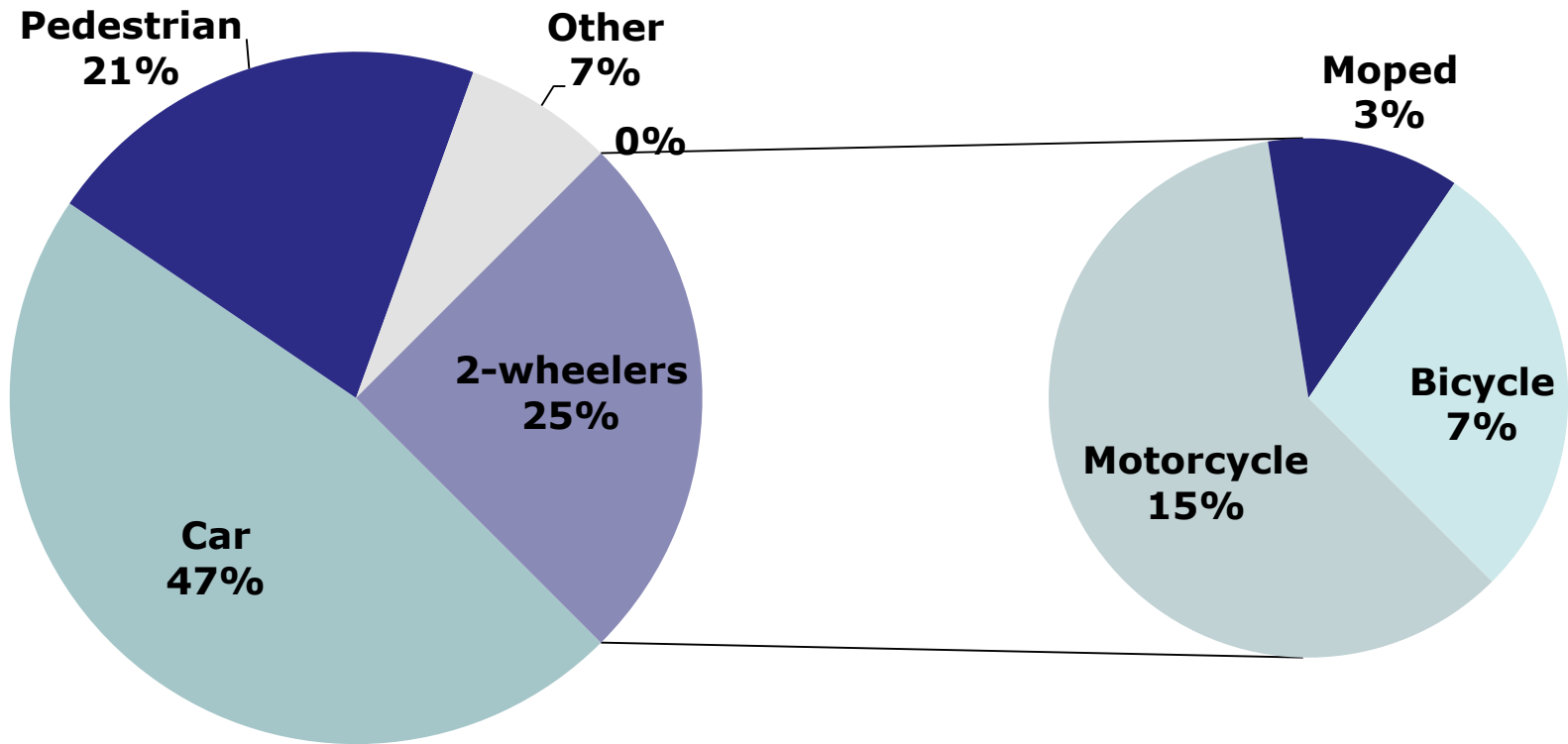


Were we are

- Develop a strategy

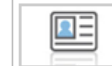
