


ROAD FATALITY RATES 2017







Risky Driving



INTEGRATED MEASURE OF A RISKY DRIVING STYLE (DRIVE THROUGH AMBER, FOLLOW TOO CLOSELY, STOP AT PEDESTRIAN CROSSING).

Larger numbers indicate a more risky driving style. Plus and minus signs indicate significant changes in relation to Sartre 3 (t-Test. p< ,05)

Israël and Serbia are not included in Sartre 3 study

To change behavior, we need to change the social environment












"It is difficult to expect that people will change their behavior easily when many forces in the **social environment** conspire against such change."








Beliefs

"Bystander Intervention involves developing the awareness, skills, and courage needed to intervene in a situation when another individual needs help."
















Align efforts across stakeholders


