Road safety measures by Bayer in Berlin

Background: stronger increase of absentism due to commuting accidents compared to occupational accidents



Road safety is a main topic of the health and safety strategy of this Bayer site:

- in 2020 focus on bicycle accidents (due to the number of accidents)
- // Regular bicycle checks free of costs in cooperation with ADFC since 2012
- // Provision of bicycle helmets as activity of Bayer in Germany
- // Offer of high-quality bicycle lighting to employees at cost price
- // Engagement of employees during the "Bayer Safety Day", eg. traffic rule quiz for cyclists
- // Collection and communication of safe routes from different city districts to Bayer
- // Awareness raising through lectures and through posters in the buildings (from DVR, BG'n)



Film project "Ich weiß ja, wie es sicher geht" – "I know how it works safely!"

- Reason = Echange of experiences regarding commuting accidents:
 - What are the respective companies doing?
 - What can we do together?
- Idea = Production of a humorous film spot presenting typical situations of each paricipating company
- Production= VDSI in cooperation with SW-Media
- Result = a film with 11 minutes of duration representing contiguous individual scenes
